



2010 CURBSIDE CLEAN UP

The City of Monroe's 2010 Curbside Clean Up will begin on Monday, April 12th and end on Friday, April 16th. During Clean Up week, residents may place additional items out with their garbage on their normal garbage day. There will be no charges for most items, however, there will be certain items that will require a fee to be paid by Friday, April 9th.

Please note that the Annual Curbside Clean Up is only available to residents within City Limits.

The following is a list of items that will be picked up for free and/or for a fee:

FREE-

- Yard waste / Wood (please make sure yard waste is placed in paper bags)
- Wood (please make sure this is cut down to 4' or smaller, bundled or placed in paper bags)
- Metals (tire chains, cycle frames, burn barrels, cable, wire, aluminum, lawn mowers, lawn chairs, copper, auto parts, windows and screens, BBQ's (no coals or propane tanks)
- Extra garbage (please make sure this is properly bagged)
- For the following items, please call us for pick up, we will not include a fee for water heaters, stoves, washer and dryers, sinks, tubs, lawn mowers (no fluid).

- Full or Queen Mattress and Box Spring Each \$30
- King Mattress and Box Spring Each \$35
- Stuffed Chair \$25

- Hutch \$35
- Carpet 8x10 \$25
- Carpet 14x16 \$30
- Carpet 18x20 \$35
- Carpet Pad 8x10 \$25

- Carpet Pad 18x20 \$35

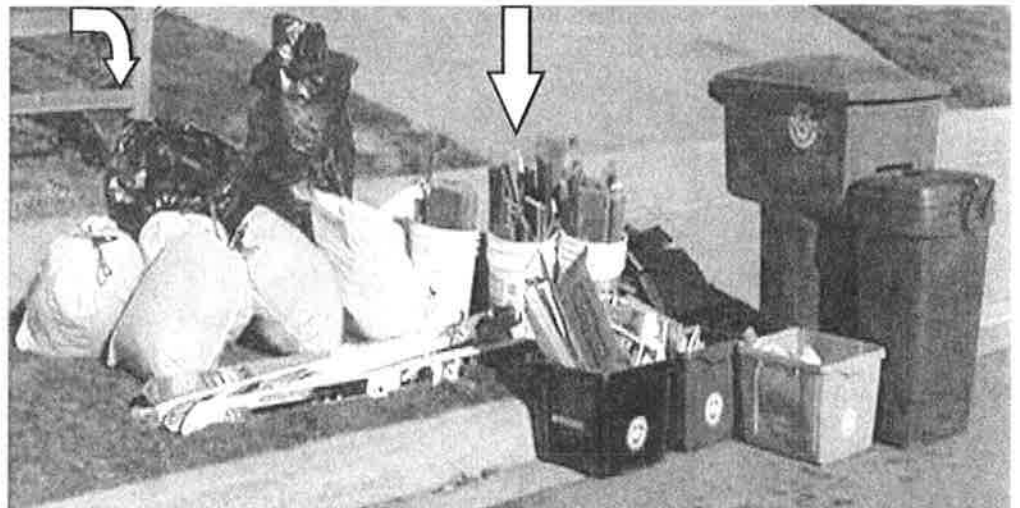
Please put your extra items out by 6am on THURSDAY April 15th for pick up

Please Properly Prepare Your Trash for Clean Up Week

PLEASE DO:

- Bag all trash.
- Cut wood 18" or smaller.
- Use twine or containers to "bundle" wood products.
- Place loose items in garbage cans, boxes, or any type of container.
