

RESOLUTION NO. 2008/006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT PAYMENTS FOR LICENSES, PERMITS, FINES, PENALTIES AND OTHER FEES IN CASH.

WHEREAS, the Monroe Police Department does not engage in transactions for payments for licenses, permits, fines, penalties or fees in cash; and

WHEREAS, with the establishment of the Violations Bureau, monetary fines and/or penalties resulting from certain infractions may be paid directly to the Violations Bureau, which is operated by the Monroe Police Department; and

WHEREAS, as a result, the Monroe Police Department expects a significant increase in the number of people wishing to make payments in cash;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In addition to other methods of payments already accepted and accounted for, the Monroe Police Department is hereby directed to accept, and account for, payments for licenses, permits, fines, penalties and other fees in cash. The Monroe Police Department shall maintain, and account for, a cash till of two hundred dollars, to be funded initially from General Fund, to facilitate the aforementioned cash transactions.
